



## Covid-19 Safety Plan for activity participants

Sept 2020

This plan is aimed at mitigating known risks around the transmission of Covid-19 as far as we possibly can whilst maintaining government guidelines.

We encourage our visitors to follow the guidelines to ensure their own and the staff's safety is priority, whilst also enjoying the activities.

- Face masks should be worn when entering the building, in communal areas and toilets.
- Other arrangements such as screens, reduced capacity and distancing markers are in place within rooms, so you can generally remove your mask inside the room, but do ask first.
- Wall mounted sanitizer dispensers are installed around the building with signage at appropriate locations and should be applied at the front door on entering the building, as well as before and after touching things, especially door handles etc.
- Everyone should maintain 2 metre distancing at all times and keep to the left if passing in corridors and stairways.
- Only one at a time in the lift please
- Your Group Leader will have a plan to run your group safely, so please adhere to it.

### Auditorium Hire / Fitness class

- Please be as self contained as possible, e.g. bring your own mat & drink. Please bring with you only what you need if possible no additional bags, coats etc. The Cafe is currently not open.
- There is a maximum of 12 attendees per class and an X will mark the spot where to stand.
- A booking system will be in place and will be down to the attendees to contact the centre to book in **prior** to the class. This can be done by ringing and speaking to reception on 0161 213 1920 before 14.00 Monday – Friday. Details will be taken for track and trace purposes.
- There will be a one way system in place and customers should line up social distancing in the corridor.
- The instructor will ensure that only the people who have booked attend the class.
- The room will be cleaned prior to the use. It will be down to the customer to ensure that touch point areas are kept to a minimum for example door handles, surfaces, switches, balustrades etc. Hand sanitizer and wipes will be added to each room. .
- Furniture should not be moved around in the room unless stated before hand and rearranged by LCA staff.

### Toilets.

- We have taken various sinks and booths out of use to help maintain distancing, sanitizer & wipes will be available outside and inside the toilets.
- Only touch door handles etc if you've just washed your hands (on the way out) or sanitized etc on the way in. Maintain 'one in one out' wherever possible, if in doubt, knock & shout, and if you can't wait, you can use the adapted toilets.
- Please put the lid down when flushing, this will help to prevent spread.
- Toilets are cleaned thoroughly every morning, and we will provide spray cleaner in each toilet. If you spot any issues, please alert a member of Cornerstone staff straight away.

We aim to ensure that your experience with us will be the same as it used to be, so relax, have fun and enjoy yourself. If you have any concerns please contact the centre and we will do our very best to reassure you.
