Values led company; any surpluses are reinvested in providing additional benefits for local people. Main income is from occupancy charges (rent) and contracts/earned income towards projects & service commissions. (11 staff, turnover approx £400k p.a.)

Aim: 'To improve the Health & Wellbeing of the people of Salford and particularly those of Seedley & Langworthy'.

We manage Langworthy Cornerstone Community Centre for the benefit of local people, primarily those living within 10 minutes walk of the centre. We manage, provide, promote and develop a range of services appropriate to the needs of local people such as: A healthy food project including a cafe, cookery classes, advice & volunteering opportunities, Health & Wellbeing activities, including a Smoking Cessation Project, Volunteering Project, Zumba & fitness, Active Seniors, Reiki, knitting social group, computer skills, basic skills, ESOL classes, street dance, stage school, plus much more. We also have sessions for people with more specific needs including Parent Craft plus advice (CAB & Job Club etc) & support sessions.

We conduct regular research to see how participation in our activities is affecting people and to help us plan for the future. We both arrange & participate in local community events to promote health & wellbeing and the services on offer. We work closely in partnership with a range of organisations including those based in the building (GP Surgery & Surestart Children's Centre) and seek to add value by working together. We also rent out a variety of rooms on an hourly basis, and also have supported office
